2021 Cattlemen's Congress National Hereford Show

Due to the recent cancellation of the 2021 National Western Stock Show, the American Hereford Association (AHA) board of directors recently voted to recognize the 2021 Cattlemen's Congress, Oklahoma City, OK to be held Jan. 4-17, 2021, as a National Hereford show.

Junior Heifer Show – Jan. 7, 2021

National Bull Show – Jan. 8, 2021

Pen Show - Jan. 9, 2021

National Sale – Jan. 9, 2021

National Heifer Show – Jan. 10, 2021

The AHA will release additional information concerning entry deadlines, arrival, hotel accommodations, show and sale informational it becomes available. This information will be available on the AHA social media outlets and www.hereford.org. ★

Houston Stock Show to Have Junior Show Only

The Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo announced its commitment to the 2021 Junior Livestock Show, supporting the Rodeo's mission of promoting agriculture and supporting Texas youth. In order to safely host a livestock competition and follow the health and safety guidelines, the 2021 Livestock Show will focus primarily on the Junior Show and select Youth Show events, foregoing its mostly adult-focused Open Show.

“Our efforts will be focused on providing a safe experience for our Junior Show exhibitors in 2021, which aligns with our mission of promoting agriculture and supporting Texas youth,” said Chris Boleman, Rodeo president and CEO. “Our Open Show exhibitors are an integral part of our Show every year, and this decision was not made lightly, but with the health and safety of all our exhibitors and guests at the forefront of our decision.”

The Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo is planning for participants to be able to compete in the 2021 Houston Livestock Show Junior Show, following the necessary health and safety protocols in place. Specific health and safety guidelines for Junior Show exhibitors will be posted as soon as they are finalized. Livestock entries for the 2021 Junior Show will open Nov. 15 and close Dec. 15, 2020. Junior Show competitions include Breeding Beef Heifers, Breeding Gilts, Breeding Sheep, Dairy Cattle, Market Barrows, Market Broilers, Market Goats, Market Lambs, Market Steers and Market Turkeys. In addition, various judging competitions and contests will be held, including Ag Mechanics, Archery, Industrial Craft, and Young Guns Shooting Sports and some virtual events like the Ag Science Fair and Public Speaking Contests. Youth competitions that will take place include Youth Meat Pen Rabbits, Youth Breeding Rabbit/Cavy, and Llama & Alpaca shows.

By foregoing the Open Show and

focusing primarily on the Junior Show, it limits the number of participants on-site and allows event organizers to spread out Junior Show events over a longer period of time, allowing for the proper health and safety measures to be followed for the safety of exhibitors and guests.

“While our 2021 Livestock Show might look different amidst COVID-19, we are optimistic that we will be able to welcome back our Open Show exhibitors to the Rodeo grounds in 2022 and give them the experience that they deserve and expect at the Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo,” Boleman said.

Additional plans for the 2021 Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo, as well as full health and safety guidelines will be announced toward the end of the year. ★

Dr. T. Ward Locklear

Dr. Travis Ward Locklear, 80, of Brownwood passed away, November 6, 2020.

Ward was born August 1, 1940, to Andrew Francis “Jock” Locklear and Marjorie Nell (Owen) Locklear and grew up in San Saba.

After a brief time in the United States Army, Ward came back close to home and began his medical practice in Brownwood, Texas. However, the donors of the Heritage Pen of heifers have offered for the twentieth year to donate not one but two pens of heifers. This year we will be selling one

pen of pure Herefords and one pen of Angus X Hereford crossbred heifers on February 6, 2021 in the All-breed commercial heifer sale organized to replace the annual Stock Show all-breed sale. I encourage members to help solicit buyers for this pen. I know how good the heifers will develop into cows. THA is greatly appreciative for these contributions. These members have made a giant effort to ensure great things for THA and Hereford cattle. The rest of THA needs to step up by attending and either buying or bringing buyers to the sales and shows.

December and the time between Thanksgiving and Christmas and the New Year is always a time to pause and reflect on the past year and plan for the upcoming year. I am most thankful for good health and the opportunity to work for THA. I wish everyone a safe, healthy and happy holiday season and prosperous New Year. Hooked ON Hereford Beef

There's quite a bit of well-deserved buzz surrounding Ruth Hooker. Her original Hooker's Grill in the Fort Worth Stock Yards has received rave reviews, and her fried onion burgers continue popping up on menus around the city. So, when I heard that she was opening a new location in Hudson Oaks, I immediately called my editor.

Situated directly off the highway and inside Dave's Stove Shop, getting to Hooker's Grill is a snap. Parking, on the other hand, might not be. Don't be tempted by the cars in front of the building. The access road is one-way, so if what looks like a spot turns out to be a drainage ditch, you've got a frustrating 3.5-mile drive ahead of you to loop back around and try again. Trust me, turn on Mikus Road, there's ample parking there.

Once you're inside Dave's, Hooker's Grill is in the southwest corner of the building. The creaky wooden floors and exposed slats overhead lend a nice homey feel to the space. And while the indoor seating is sparse, there is a sizeable, family-friendly patio as well. It's covered and has lots of fun, outdoor furniture, and sculptures to keep the kids entertained.

The order counter displays a chalkboard menu with a prominent BYOB

And when it comes to the future of Hooker's Grill, Ruth's next step will be to add a meat counter and start retailing locally raised Hereford steaks. "All we sell is Hereford, and people love it. They love the flavor of the meat. I honestly get compliments all day long, and I just tell them it's just salt, pepper, and good old Hereford beef."★

sign. Hooker's offers standard grill fare such as patty melts and hotdogs and more unique options like Indian tacos, fried bologna sandwiches, loaded tater tots, and scratch-baked desserts. But the house specialty is the fried onion burger made with Greater Omaha Hereford Beef.


What exactly is a fried onion burger? For starters, it's delicious, and if you've never had one, it's a must-try. Invented in El Reno, Oklahoma in the 1900s, the patty is cooked on a griddle, or flat top with a generous handful of chopped raw onion pressed into the meat. This results in an incredibly flavorful burger with crunchy bits of caramelized onion in every bite.

When my name was called, I was handed a giant, paper-wrapped burger. The perfectly toasted bun had a nice buttery crunch. The Hereford beef patty was well seasoned, covered in melted cheese, and full of delicious griddle-fried onions.

I knew I couldn't miss the burger, but I also ordered a side of the Green Chili Cheese Fries, and I have to say, these are a must-try. Made from skin-on russet potatoes and drenched in cheese and green chilis, the fries remained crispy to the last bite. The gravy, which was more of a thick, warm salsa, had a nice kick and boasted citrus notes balanced by cumin and spices.

Throughout my visit, Ruth Hooker was back and forth from the kitchen to the patio, welcoming diners, delivering food, and making sure everyone was enjoying their meals. Between her trips, I was able to ask a few questions about why she had chosen Hereford beef and her plans for the future of her burger empire.

Honoring Hereford Imminence

Billy Ashe, Selmer, Tenn.; Warren and Isabel Brown, Hartland, Wis.; and John and Ginger Dudley, Comanche, Texas, were inducted into the Hereford Hall of Fame at the American Hereford Association's (AHA) Annual Membership Meeting and Conference, Oct. 24, in Kansas City, Mo. Burke Healey, Davis, OK, was posthumously inducted into the Hereford Hall of Merit.

The Hall of Fame and Merit awards are presented annually to those who have influenced the advancement of the Hereford breed and the beef industry. The Hall of Merit award recognizes those who have played a vital role in shaping both the Hereford breed and the beef industry.

"Inductees into the Hereford Hall of Fame and Merit set the bar high when it comes to the advancement and promotion of the breed," says Jack Ward, AHA executive vice president. "We are proud to honor these esteemed breeders for their great contributions to improving Hereford genetics and the nation's beef herd."

Hall of Fame

John and Ginger Dudley • Dudley Bros. Comanche, Texas

Distinguished leaders John and Ginger Dudley have left their mark on the Hereford breed in the state of Texas and across the country. In partnership with multiple family members, the pair operates Dudley Bros. in Comanche, Texas, and carries on a legacy of producing commercially focused registered Herefords.

Dudley Bros. began as a three-way partnership in 1927 between John's father and two uncles. The registered herd was added in 1938 and the operation's first of now 59 annual production sales was hosted in 1962. John, who was born and raised on the ranch, met Ginger at Trinity University in San Antonio. He later attended Thunderbird School in Arizona and then served in the U.S. Navy for four years. Two years later, John and Ginger married and settled down in Comanche. John and Ginger enjoy spending time with

their son, Gardner, and his wife, Elizabeth, along with their three grandsons Will, Thomas and Hudson.

Today, Dudley Bros. operates as a family-owned limited partnership with a limited liability company serving as the managing general partner. Currently, 14 family members are shareholders — John and Ginger Dudley, Jim and Margaret Dudley, T. J. and Kerry Dudley, Tom and Melissa Dudley, Ray and Monica Dudley, Harry and Rhonda Dudley and Julia Dudley Allison. John is the president of the Dudley Bros. LLC.

Phillip Burns of Burns Farms Herefords in Tennessee praises John and Ginger for their outstanding teamwork. He says, "John and Ginger have been the glue that has helped make the family partnership work, and the vision and strategic direction of the successful business has largely derived from their effort. Their mutual support and affection for each other is contagious."

John and Ginger have devoted countless hours serving organizations within the Hereford breed and the cattle industry. John is a past president of the Texas Hereford Association and Ginger is a past president of the Texas Hereford Women. While on the American Hereford Association Board, John was part of the merger committee, and he considers making that initiative a reality the most significant activity he was involved with as a director. His extensive leadership positions outside of the breed include serving as president of the Texas and Southwestern Cattle Raisers Association. John previously held a seat on the executive committee for the National Cattlemen's Beef Association and was chairman of the advertising committee. He was also a chairman of the Texas Beef Council.

Arthur Uhl of Powell Herefords in San Angelo, Texas, recognizes John and Ginger as "tireless advocates of not only the Hereford breed, but agriculture, conservation, culture and community as well." The couple established the Jackson Albert Dudley Scholarship fund and were leaders in forming Friends of Historic Comanche Inc. John was also

appointed to the board of regents of the Texas State University System and was an outspoken advocate for agriculture programs in the system's seven universities. Additionally, he served as director for the Texas Agricultural Land Trust.

Longtime friend and peer Jack Chastain, executive secretary for the Texas Hereford Association (THA), says John serves with purpose and sincerity in every role he holds. "John's passion for the ranch and for the Hereford breed has contributed not only to his personal ranching success but to the success of our Texas Hereford Association," Chastain says. "His business and political science degrees were most helpful in shaping programs and policies of THA."

Hall of Merit

Burke Healey • Southern Cross Ranch Davis, Oklahoma

The late Burke Healey, or "Mr. Hereford" as he is fondly remembered, is recognized as a visionary of the Hereford breed and the beef industry at large.

Burke's journey in the Hereford breed began in 1950 at the age of 18 when he and his younger brother Skip purchased the Flying L Ranch located in Davis, Okla. The partnership continued through 1988 at which time they decided to bring their children into the operations. It was then Burke renamed his portion to the Southern Cross Ranch. Burke's children continue the operation today.

A respected cattleman, Burke was ahead of his time in recording quantitative measurements and using cutting-edge data to evaluate and to improve his herd's genetics. One of his most notable achievements is developing the frame score chart, a tool widely adopted by the beef industry.

This past president of the American Hereford Association led the way in forming the Whole Herd Total Performance Records (TPR) program during his tenure on the Board. Peers and fellow directors Guy Colyer, Jack Holden, Vern Rausch and Dale Venhuizen credit Burke as a pioneer

in performance testing and as an instrumental leader in the merger of the national horned and polled associations. Burke's other influential ideas included performance pedigrees and making data available online.

As an industry leader, Burke was very active in the National Cattlemen's Beef Association, the Beef Improvement Federation (BIF) and was one of the 15 people who wrote the original Long Range Plan for the beef industry. His efforts earned him numerous awards, including the BIF Continuing Service and Pioneer awards, *BEEF Magazine's* Trailblazer of the Year and recognition in Bob deBaca's book *Courageous Cattlemen*, which described the key influencers of the U.S. beef performance movement. Burton Eller of Virginia, a former executive vice president of the National Cattlemen's Association, says, "Burke was never afraid to stand up to advocate for a promising new idea or to defend a tried and true principle. He always had both feet planted firmly on solid ground and was a true thinker for Herefords and for the beef industry."

At home, Burke was very active in community organizations and was often the name behind an anonymous donation supporting the emerging leaders of local 4-H and FFA programs. Roger Stuber of North Dakota describes Burke as "a man who gave more than he got" who was "honest, willing, dedicated to purpose and a true Hereford leader."

Bob Drake, past president of the National Cattlemen's Beef Association, remembers Burke as a mentor, teacher and an individual who could relate to every part of the cattle industry. He says, "When we lost Burke Healey, we lost a giant who represented the Hereford industry, all of the cattle industry and all of agriculture."

Although Burke has been posthumously inducted into the Hereford Hall of Merit, his firm belief in Hereford cattle and their contribution to the genetic pool of the nation's beef herd is a legacy that will continue to live on.

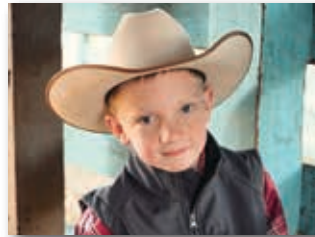

All steers were fed at Gregory Feedlots in Tabor, IA, and through a generous sponsorship from Texas Stardance Cattle of Hamilton, steers were hauled to and harvested at National Beef Packing Co. in Dodge City, KS, as candidates for the Certified Hereford Beef® brand. Allflex USA, Ultrainsights Processing Lab, Endovac Animal Health, Geneseek and Fremont County Vet also played a vital role in the success of the program.

Additionally, contestants entered performance portfolios from data reports they received throughout the feeding period and wrote an essay about what they learned from the process. New this year, Beef Quality Assurance was an added requirement for those juniors participating in the performance portfolio portion of the contest.
