## Attention Juniors: \$4,000 for Top Jr. in 2022 Fort Worth National Show

THA Foundation has committed \$4,000 to the exhibitor of the highest placing heifer and \$2,000 to the second highest placing heifer at the 2022 Muleshoe Ranch National Hereford Show in Fort Worth on January 30, 2022. A third and fourth place scholarship of \$1,000 will also be awarded. To be eligible to receive these awards, the exhibitor must be a member of TJHA, be eligible to show in the junior show the previous week (exhibitor does not have to exhibit at the junior show) and be at the halter of his/her heifer. No cow/calf is eligible. The ownership rules for the junior show must be met. See rule 10 on page 146 of the Fort Worth Stock Show premium book.

Each facility provides livestock buyers and sellers with a location on the Texas border where animals can be held until inspection and export requirements are completed. Once the livestock have been cleared for travel, they can be loaded for transport out of the United States.

Livestock leaving the Brownsville, Del Rio, El Paso, and Laredo facilities will be loaded for ground transport into Mexico. The Houston facility moves livestock by air and sea, covering destinations all over the world.

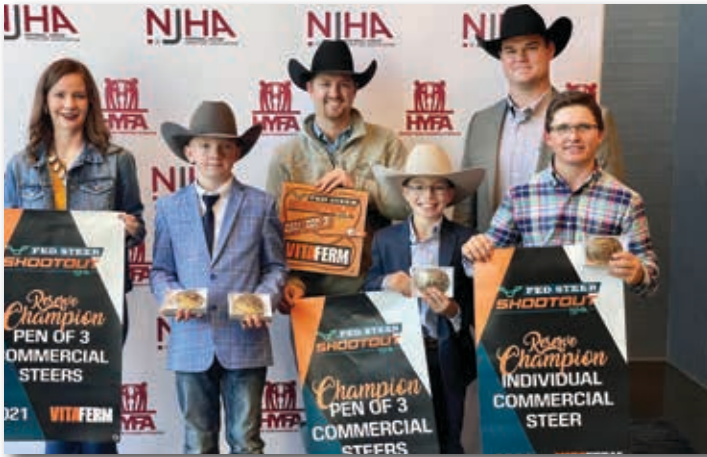

**Noack Herefords**

Noack Herefords, Rockdale, Texas, was established in 1921 by E.H. Noack, who registered the 7- brand. When E.H.'s only son, Leon, returned home from Texas A&M, his graduation was rewarded when he was named the cow herd manager. After E.H.'s untimely death a few years later, Leon assumed full respon-

sibility for the ranch and made it into the operation it is today.

Leon spent countless hours studying pedigrees and collecting performance data. Noack Herefords was an early adopter of the Total Performance Registry Program. The operation focused on creating the ideal mama cow, improving birth weights, milking ability and longevity.

Leon spent time working as a meat grader, which taught him the value of consistently producing delicious, tender meat. He was diagnosed with Alzheimer's disease in 2000 and lost the battle in 2015.

Today, the family ranch consists of three separate cow herds that cooperate on genetics and marketing. Noack bulls are guaranteed to work for four years.

Noack Herefords firmly believes form follows function, and the most functional cows are also the most profitable. They have been tremendously blessed and hope to operate another 100 years.

#### Smathers Ranch

The Smathers Hereford Ranch, Llano, Texas, was established in 1886 by James Jefferson Smathers in the heart of the Texas Hill Country in Llano County, Texas. James purchased about 500 acres shortly after he married Harriet Spinks, and he purchased his first Hereford cattle shortly after. Over the past 135 years, the ranch has passed from father to son for five generations.

The Smathers Ranch has evolved from 500 acres of raw pastureland to a highly managed, improved grasses, cultivated fields and rotational cell-grazing operation, which maximizes herd production and capacity.

## D.G. Talbot Memorial Scholarship

Dan Talbot of Fort Worth, Texas has made a donation to the Texas Hereford Association Foundation for a \$1,500 scholarship to be awarded to a high school senior or college freshman and member of the Texas Junior Hereford Association. Scholarship will be awarded at the THA Annual Meeting in Fort Worth, January 29, 2022. This scholarship is in honor of Dan's father, D.G. Talbot, for a student in the College of Agriculture at Texas A&M University. ★

### D.G. Talbot

Raised in Fort Worth, D.G. Talbot enrolled at Texas A&M College in 1922. He was a member of the Cadet Corps, the Ross Brigade, the polo team, and the national champion junior livestock judging team. He showed champion Morgan and Percheron horses for the college and graduated in 1926 (A&M's Golden Anniversary year) with a B.S. in agriculture (one of 52 in that major).

Through his Aggie roommate, R.A. Brown, Mr. Talbot made his start in the cattle business. He leased one of the Tom Parrott ranches in Throckmorton County and bought 150 registered Hereford heifers, bred by Jones & Dameron, and three herd bulls: Superior 8, Domino 39th, and Super Anxiety 8. The first calves sold for \$90 a head.

With a Model T Ford, a bedroll, and a saddle, he moved to the ranch on Jan. 1, 1928, and immediately joined the Texas Hereford Association. Batching there, he tended his cattle and did his own farming with teams of horses and mules, until the drought and Great Depression forced him to liquidate.

Returning to Fort Worth, Mr. Talbot served as secretary of the Texas Hereford Association (1931-1933) and as livestock superintendent and later assistant manager of the Southwestern Exposition & Fat Stock Show. Leasing pastures from Amon Carter, he started back in the cattle business with registered and commercial Herefords and stocker calves. In 1938, he purchased his own ranch near Aledo in Parker County.

Three weeks after Pearl Harbor, Capt. Talbot, who had remained active in the Army Reserves since graduation, married Mary Wynn of Fort Worth. She ably managed the ranch during the 27 months her husband served overseas during World War II. He commanded a First Armored Division tank battalion in the North African campaign and was awarded the Silver Star for gallantry in action and promoted to lieutenant colonel.

Col. Talbot returned to ranching and over the next three decades expanded his cattle operations on leases in several North Texas counties.

He died at the age of 70 on Epiphany, January 6, 1976, and was survived by his widow Mary (1914-2001) and three children. ★


