## Attention Juniors: \$4,000 for Top Jr. in 2022 Fort Worth National Show

THA Foundation has committed \$4,000 to the exhibitor of the highest placing heifer and \$2,000 to the second highest placing heifer at the 2022 Muleshoe Ranch National Hereford Show in Fort Worth on January 30, 2022. A third and fourth place scholarship of \$1,000 will also be awarded. To be eligible to receive these awards, the exhibitor must be a member of TJHA, be eligible to show in the junior show the previous week (exhibitor does not have to exhibit at the junior show) and be at the halter of his/her heifer. No cow/calf is eligible. The ownership rules for the junior show must be met. See rule 10 on page 146 of the Fort Worth Stock Show premium book.

## Fall 2021 Platinum and Gold TPR Breeders Announced

Five Hereford breeders achieved Platinum Total Performance Records (TPR) Breeder status for fall 2021.

The Platinum TPR program was established in 2018 to recognize breeders who participate in the Association's Whole Herd Total Performance Records (TPRTM) program that was implemented in 2001 to create a more accurate database and increase the value of Hereford genetics. The Platinum TPR Breeder is the highest level of achievement when it comes to complete calf crop reporting. Breeders must meet all of the requirements of Gold TPR Breeder status plus genotype 85% of their calves with a weaning weight submitted.

The Platinum and Gold TPR Breeder awards are designated two times a year and are awarded each calving season. The selection of Platinum and Gold TPR breeders takes place during the process of loading each new run of expected progeny differences in January (spring) and July (fall). The criteria for Platinum and Gold TPR breeders will be evaluated two years prior to the award year. The following fall 2021 TPR awards reflect the fall 2019 calf crop.

Thirty-eight Hereford breeders achieved Gold TPR status for fall 2021.

Established in 2005, the program pays tribute to breeders who go the extra mile to collect data at all levels of production and report the data in a timely manner. The Gold TPR Breeder recognition is presented to progressive Hereford breeders who have measured traits and collected and promptly submitted performance data at all levels of production.

Congratulations to these Texas Hereford Association members and Texas breeders. Platinum TPR breeders include Express Ranches, Yukon, OK; Holden Herefords, Valier, MT; Rocker b Ranch, Barnhart. Gold TPR breeders include Colyer Herefords, Bruneau, ID; Double Diamond Ranch, McDade; Doyle Hereford Ranch, Wolfe City; JP Family Limited Partnership, San Angelo; Noack Herefords, LLC, Rockdale; P&J Polled Herefords, La Vernia; Still River Ranch, Van Alstyne. ★

As we approach the end of the month, many of our production sales are over. Results have been solid as shown in the reports listed elsewhere in this issue. Hereford cattle continue to gain ground in the overall beef industry. It is very rewarding to hear comments from some of the buyers saying that they are buying Herefords because their Hereford sired calves are out-performing their calves sired by bulls of other breeds. They are talking both higher percent calf crop as well as heavier calves at weaning. THA members should be proud of the product you are producing but never rest, as we need to continue to improve the seedstock we provide to the industry.

I am happy to report that the Fort Worth Stock show plans to resume having a show in 2022. Therefore, THA can resume our regular schedule of activities normally conducted during the show. We plan to have our annual membership meeting on Saturday afternoon, January 29, 2022, at the Botanical Gardens. The facility has added some new restrictions we are working to resolve, but plan on attending. We plan to keep sponsoring a pen bull show as well as the annual Powerhouse commercial heifer show and sale. Entries are due now for both events. Our executive committee decided not to sponsor a halter cattle sale at Fort Worth this year. If interest in this improves, we will consider resuming it in 2023.

THA still plans to have our fund-raising Heritage Pen of heifers that will sell in our Powerhouse commercial sale on

Sunday, January 30, 2022. With the generosity of a number of THA members, we have expanded this project by having not only a pen of Hereford heifer calves, but a pen of Hereford X Black Angus cross and a pen of Hereford X Red Angus cross heifers. Our executive committee would greatly appreciate any help in selling these three pens.

Our THA Foundation will still provide our annual scholarship, the Gray-Wynn-Klein memorial scholarship and a new Denny Fuston memorial scholarship. Applications will be due January 1, 2022 and recipients will be announced at the annual meeting on Saturday, January 29, 2022.

I wish to single out and thank the consignors to our eleventh annual Fall Classic Sale in Buffalo. The top of our offering was well accepted, and sale prices reflected this. This is an event for all members of THA. We hope to grow this sale more and more each year. Please consider saving a top bull or female for next years event.

I urge all members to stay in touch with the officers of this organization. We have a few new projects in place and plans for many more. We welcome ideas and suggestions from members as to what they would like this organization to be doing.

November is a month we should give thanks for the many blessings that have been bestowed upon us. We are truly blessed to work with Hereford cattle and the fine people associated with them. ★

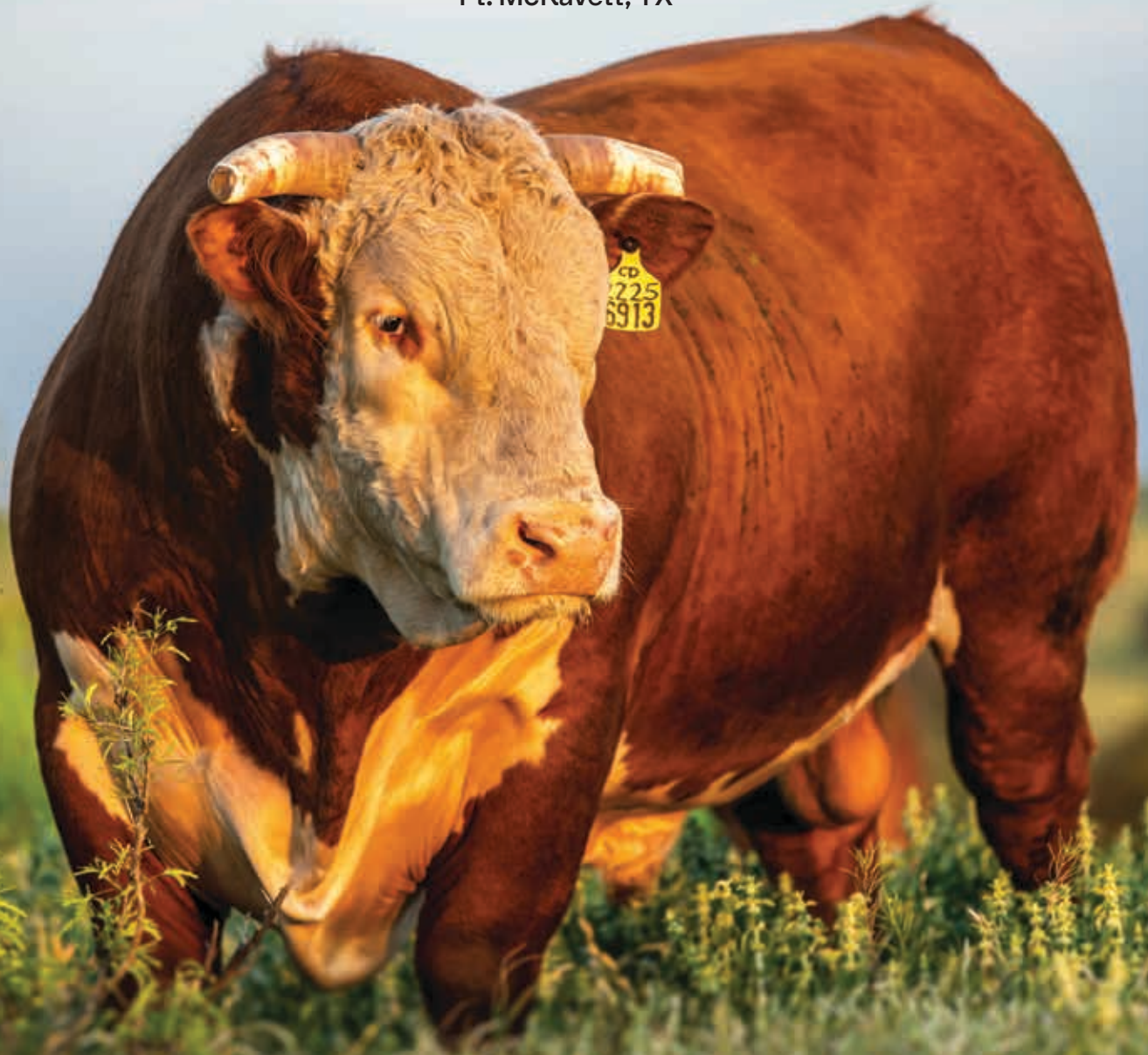

# MIXING IT UP

with food & folks

**H**urry, hurry, step this way for the most eclectic eatery I've reviewed so far. You've never seen more exotic burgers or curious bar food options packed into a single menu. Ladies and gentlemen, right here, right now, discover all the unique beers hailing from all four corners of this great state of Texas. Flavors that will dazzle your senses at prices that will make you smile. Hurry, hurry, hurry, it can all be yours, yes, all yours, if you continue reading below.

Cornhole bags were flying, children were laughing, and the tables in the large outdoor yard in front of The Bearded Lady were nearly full when I arrived for happy hour. I was appreciating the eclectic crowd of cowboys, doctors, businessmen, and families when a tattooed lady approached me, offered me a menu, and led me inside.

The interior decor was decidedly industrial, with plenty of metal, wood, and exposed ductwork. But this was well balanced by wicker lampshades, a floor-to-ceiling painting of saguaro cacti, and a few flower arrangements. There was a cheerful crowd in the bar area and adjoining community tables, so I took my menu to the last available stool and was immediately greeted by Lexi and Courtney.

Throughout my visit, Lexi and Courtney were attentive and helpful. Like twins attached at the hip, they always seemed to be together. They led me through the extensive beer list and provided commentary on the current trends in

tattoos, piercings, and colored hair. After deciding that I needed a "Mom" tattoo for my forearm, a gold ring for my nose, and a red and blue dye job, they moved on to the food menu.

The Bearded Lady offered a diverse array of bar food classics, each with an exciting twist to make them feel unique while not straying too far from comfortable. The Texas Smoke Salad, for example, was a play on a chopped salad but with honey pecans, smoked gouda, and herb ranch. While the Best Made Martin House Dill Queso was a traditional cheese dip except for a bit of dill pickle-flavored beer mixed in for pizzazz. And although this all sounded delicious, it was actually the enormous burgers made with Hereford beef that piqued my interest.

Now listen, if decisions stress you out, don't try building a custom burger at The Bearded Lady. Go with the house favorites. There were so many different add-ons, I was utterly overwhelmed. I counted eight different kinds of cheese, six different proteins such as bacon and pulled pork, as well as pickled onions, roasted corn, grilled mushrooms, and the list went on and on. Only one thing came standard, on the BYO burger, the eight-ounce Hereford beef

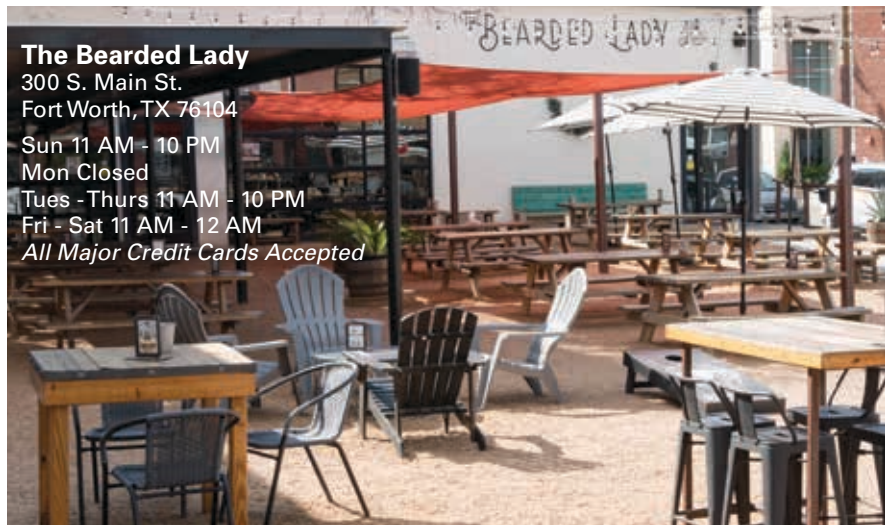


patty. So rather than going crazy building a Frankin-burger, I decided to trust in the chef's creations.

The My Oh My it's Frito Pie Burger was topped with fried cheddar cheese, corn chips, spicy house-made chili, and a rich sour cream sauce. I assumed this was going to be a knife and fork burger but was pleasantly surprised that despite the generous helping of chili poured over the patty, the bun remained intact, and the sandwich stayed together in my hand. I also really appreciated the different textures in each bite. The crunchy chips, the crispy cheese, and the tender Hereford beef played well together.

Next was the Spicy AF burger. Topped with deep-fried Fresno peppers, grilled jalapenos, melted pepper jack cheese, and fiery habanero aioli, this burger was indeed spicy. I didn't feel like a fire eater, though, and was still able to enjoy the individual flavors as well as the delicious Hereford beef.

Each burger also came with a choice of sides and although there were many exciting options, I felt obligated to try the fries served with homemade catsup. I was impressed. They were thick-cut and well

seasoned with salt, pepper, and grated parmesan cheese. The house-made catsup was a tangy spicy treat with a sharp chili bite that was a real stand-out for me.

For a small upcharge, I opted for the mac and cheese as my second side. It was one of the best I've ever had. The elbow macaroni was cooked to a perfect al dente, covered in a creamy sharp cheddar sauce, and served with a buttery, bread crumb crust. The flavor was outstanding.

In the end, I admit that I think The Bearded Lady is a strange name for a restaurant, and honestly, when my editor asked me to check it out, I wasn't sure what I'd find. But after enjoying two whole burgers, two sides, and feeling like the fattest man on earth, I can say that The Bearded Lady is so much more than a sideshow attraction. Hurry, Hurry, Hurry and check it out! ★

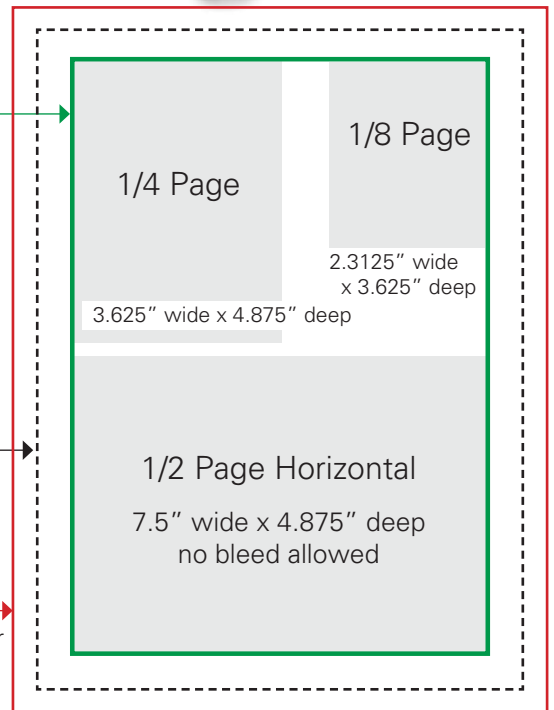


