'Rounding Up' Support

for WT Rehab Center

Concho Valley Family Finds Care, Expertise Close to Home

While West Texas ranchers and farmers are “roping” in support for this fall’s Round-Up for Rehab events, five-year-old Gunner is trying his best to lasso a goat or a family pet – not aware he’s one of the many reasons for this annual fundraising campaign that’s as traditional as it gets.

Now in its 62nd year, Round-Up for Rehab helps provide care and treatment daily for more than 650 patients of all ages – including Gunner – who receive top quality services at West Texas Rehabilitation Center facilities in Abilene, San Angelo and Ozona.

The philosophy is simple yet sincere and reflects the neighbor-helping-neighbor attitude prevalent throughout the Big Country and Concho Valley – basically West Central Texas and beyond.

Headed by Rehab Center spokesman and Western performer Red Steagall, the long-time drive will kick off in September as special sales and mailings will encourage donations of animals, ag products and cash.

Assisted by Randy Carson, John Ekdahl and Ikie Taylor in Abilene and Bob Helmers and Jody Frey in San Angelo, more than 125 ag industry volunteers will fan out to raise awareness and support.

Sale events where donated animals and goods will be up for bid are Abilene Auction, September 14; Producers Auction in San Angelo, September 16; Coleman Auction, October 6 and Stephenville Auction, October 9.

Round-Up donors will help ensure young Gunner and his ranching family -- and hundreds of children and adults with physical disabilities and communication disorders – will receive independence and skills necessary to overcome challenges such as his rare syndrome which causes growth delay, feeding difficulties, poor muscle tone and vision and hearing issues.

Pediatric physical therapist Leslie Ashlock adds that at West Texas Rehab, “Gunner is working on functional mobility skills such as walking on uneven surfaces and climbing on playground equipment so he can keep up with his parents and playmates.”

Before West Texas Rehab Center became Gunner’s source of care, this Sterling City family had to travel to Fort Worth three times weekly and visit more than a dozen specialists.

Now parents Jeff and Katrina make the short drive to San Angelo where this curious young cowboy receives physical and occupational therapy, speech and audiology twice a week.

Playing a large role in this family’s challenging journey was Cinco Cattle Company co-owner Sarena Terry who had hired Jeff as her foreman and facilitated a meeting with personnel at West Texas Rehab where she is a board member.

Back in 1960 when Ft. Chadbourne ranchers Conda and Edna Wylie donated that first pen of steers for the Round-Up, they encouraged neighbors to join in the vital effort – hoping to make good things possible for a handful of children suffering from cerebral palsy at the fledging Rehab Center. Little did they and WTRC founder Shelley Smith know their gifts would still be spurring giving today.

West Texas Rehab CEO Steve Martin says “to have had so many decades of support from ranchers and ag-related businesses simply humbles us and makes us even more committed to using these resources to help the most patients possible.”

Established in 1953, the Center is respected far and wide for its comprehensive services including physical, occupational and speech therapy, audiology, hospice and bereavement, employer services, orthotics and prosthetics and family support services.

Entertainer Red Steagall has been “riding” for West Texas Rehab’s brand since the beginning of the new millennium. Always an

Over the last few years, there's been a glut of newfangled restaurant chains doing all sorts of weird stuff to their burgers. They're smashing patties, using soy-based "meat", and I've even seen a place that put crickets and worms between a bun and called it food! Maybe I'm old-fashioned, but when I eat a burger, I want it thick and juicy, made from 100% Hereford beef, and as bug-free as possible. Thankfully, Mr. Casey Waits agrees with me. His family's been serving old fashioned hamburgers out of a little brick building down in Cleburne since 1949.

On my recent visit to 1949 Burger Bar, the first thing I noticed was just how small the restaurant was. The 12 foot by 12 foot red brick building sat in a large parking lot with four outdoor picnic tables, a make shift hand-sink, and a Porta Potty.

The front of the restaurant is dominated by a comfortable turquoise bench which is shaded by a cute little awning. Once inside, I was greeted warmly by the two extremely busy employees: Nikki, the chef, and Heather, the manager. Nikki was a blur of flipping burgers and frying fries as she kept up with the steady flow of walk-in customers and phone orders. Heather floated around, answering the phone and stuffing food into to-go bags while she chatted with everyone who called or walked in the door. Both ladies were super friendly and professional.

The menu was a collection of specialty burgers named in honor of Cleburne's rich history as well as the

usual standards like grilled cheese and a patty melt. There was even a burger challenge called The Beast Challenge. Finish it in ten minutes and it's on the house.

After I ordered, I was again struck by just how small the space was. There was an eight-foot counter with three stools. To the left, of that there was a glass front cooler full of Dr. Pepper, Big Red, and iced tea. Everything else was kitchen. You can literally reach out and touch the boxes of potatoes and trays of buns next to chef Nikki. The tight space made me feel like I was part of the action and part of the family.

As I enjoyed my ice-cold Big Red, a regular sitting next to me shared that he had been coming to 1949 Burger Bar his whole life. His first memory of the place was on a day when he and his grandfather had gone fishing and didn't catch anything. This sparked a family tradition, and today he brings his own grandkids by every couple of weeks.

The burgers arrived tightly wrapped in paper with an overflowing cornucopia of perfectly seasoned, hand-cut fries. I started with the Bledsoe. Named after William Bledsoe, founder of Texas Tech University, the sandwich was covered in melted American cheese and crispy fried onion strings. The 1/3-pound 100% Hereford beef patty was perfectly cooked, and the addition of barbeque sauce really brought the flavors together.

I also ordered the Bailey Burger. Named after the manager Heather's father, and not for the faint at heart, the Hereford beef patty is stacked high with grilled onions and jalapenos, bacon, chipotle aioli, and cheese. Then all that is crammed into a bun that has even more jalapenos baked into it. My mouth was on fire, but man, it tasted good!

Between bites of burger and sips of Big Red, I asked Heather what had inspired 1949 Burger Bar to serve 100% Hereford beef. Apparently, they've been serving Hereford since day one. "When we took over the business, the previous owner already served Hereford. The customers loved it, so we said if it ain't broken, don't fix it! We'll always serve Hereford beef here. We won't use anything else."

Amen to that! ★

Wins Rangeland Stewardship Award

The Texas & Southwestern Cattle Raisers Association announced Dry Creek Ranch, owned by Carl and Pat Schlinke of San Angelo, as the winner of the Outstanding Rangeland Stewardship Award. This recognition is a joint effort between Texas & Southwestern Cattle Raisers Association, the Texas Section Society for Range Management and Texas Grazing Land Coalition.

Texas & Southwestern Cattle Raisers Association President Hughes Abell said this is one of the most prestigious honors a rancher can win, and the competition is incredibly tough.

“Every day, cattle raisers across the country work to leave the land a little better than they found it,” Abell said. “Their love for the land, coupled with their desire for long-term sustainability, leads them to continuously strive to identify and implement the latest and best management practices. The Schlinkes are a prime example of stewardship exemplified, and we’re proud to present them with this award.”

Abell said from the very beginning, the Schlinkes put sustainability at the forefront of their ranch priorities.

While finishing a tour as a veterinarian in the U.S. Army, Carl was deployed when Pat began working with the local USDA National Resources Conversation Service to begin a water catching project on their ranch. Limited rainfall and restricted watershed availability pushed the Schlinkes to establish miles of pipe to capture natural water, gravity drawn, to water holding tanks at locations across their 3,800-acre property.

In their arid region of the state, grazing grass is often overtaken by invasive prickly pear, mesquite and juniper tree populations. To preserve grazing pasture and protect the integrity of the land, the Schlinkes work with a commercial burn manager to facilitate prescribed burn programs on their ranch, ultimately returning nutrients

to the soil for optimal soil health.

The couple established a strong forage program by aerating and seeding approximately half of their ranch with improved grass species, which they steward with acceptable stocking rates of cattle for their area.

“The land supporting Dry Creek Ranch has been a part of the Schlinke family heritage since 1902, and not by happenstance,” Abell said. “A dedication to cultivating grass establishment, water resources, land improvement and youth involvement has allowed the Schlinkes to steward a legacy. ★


