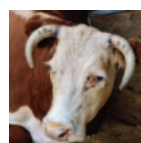
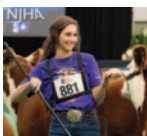

A Legacy in the Making

BR Belle Air 6011 Honored with 2026 Prestige Animal Award

The spirit of the American West was on full display on March 7, 2026, as industry leaders gathered in Amarillo to recognize the recipients of the Tri-State Fair & Rodeo 2026 Western Legacy Awards. Among the night's most anticipated honors was the Prestige Animal Award, presented to a sire whose influence has reshaped the modern Hereford landscape: BR Belle Air 6011.

Owned with Colyer Herefords and King Herefords and bred by Barber Ranch of Channing, Texas, Belle Air has ascended to a league of his own, proving that a single animal can bridge the gap between the purple banners of the show ring and the rugged demands of the commercial range.

THE BIRTH OF A GAME-CHANGER

For the Barber's, the "Belle Air story" began with a realization that something exceptional had arrived. In an era where Hereford genetics were often defined by massive growth at the expense of calving ease, Belle Air broke the mold the moment he hit the ground.

"We knew he was going to be special the day he was born," Justin Barber recalled. "He weighed just 61 pounds and was out of a first-calf heifer. Back then, the breed had

plenty of power, but it was rare to find a bull with that kind of low birth weight coupled with such explosive growth."

As he matured, the "spread" from birth to yearling weight became

only part of the equation. Belle Air eventually revealed phenomenal carcass quality and marbling—traits that have since made him a staple for progressive breeders aiming for high-value end products.

DOMINANCE FROM COAST TO COAST

Belle Air's resume reads like a roadmap of the Hereford breed's highest achievements. A two-time Denver Supreme Champion and Champion Hereford of the World, his phenotype—characterized by extra stoutness and rugged masculinity—has become the gold standard.

However, his true legacy is measured in the success of his

progeny. To date, Belle Air has more than 2,150 registered offspring, with a decade's worth of sons and grandsons continuing to dominate national shows. "His influence isn't confined to the Texas Panhandle; he has been utilized heavily by breeders from coast to coast in the U.S., as well as internationally in Canada, Mexico, and South America," Terri Barber said.

ROOTS IN THE PANHANDLE

Despite his global reach, Belle Air's journey remains rooted in local tradition. Fittingly, his first-ever outing was at the Tri-State Fair, a cornerstone event for the Barber family for generations. "We have been going to the Tri-State Fair my

entire life," Justin Barber noted. "It's the first place we get our cattle out before the national shows, and it's where the world first got a look at Belle Air."

The awards ceremony in Amarillo served as a broader celebration of the icons that drive the Western way of life. Alongside the celebration of Belle Air, the 2026 Western Legacy Awards honored a distinguished group of Panhandle leaders:

- Jim Jennings, Amarillo was inducted into the Western Heritage Hall of Fame.
- Andy Holloway of Canadian was named the 2026 Outstanding Ag Educator.
- Kay Lynn McLaughlin, CEO of Plains Land Bank, was recognized as the 2026 Leading Lady in Ag.
- Oliver Saddle Shop in Amarillo took home the award for 2026 Outstanding Ag Business.

As the evening concluded, the sentiment in the room was clear: while records may be broken and show seasons will pass, the influence of a sire like BR Belle Air 6011 is permanent. He didn't just win banners; he improved the cattle, the breed, and the bottom line for cattlemen across the globe.

As the Hereford breed continues to evolve, the recognition of BR Belle Air 6011 serves as a reminder that the best genetics aren't just about numbers on a page—they are about the lasting impact an animal leaves on the land and the people who steward it.

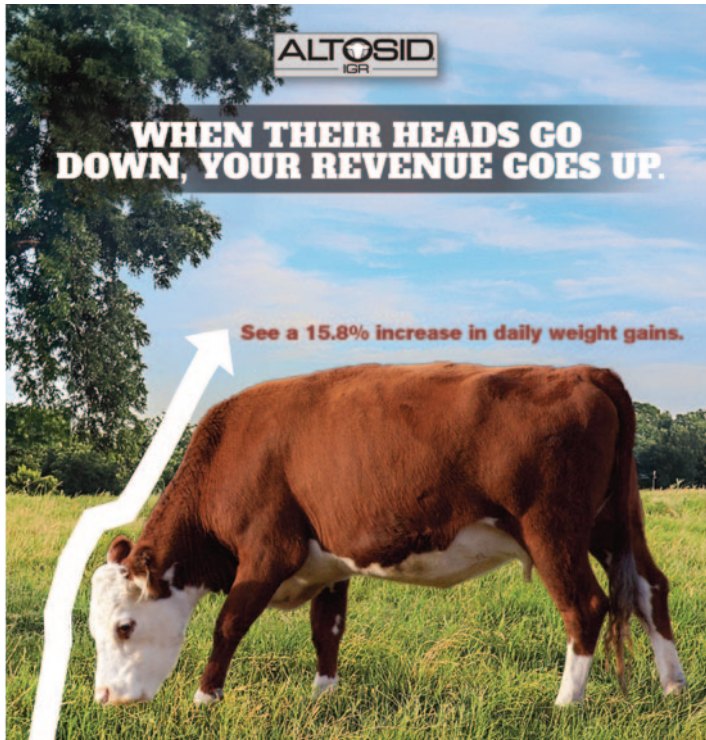

XIT Ranch: A Texas Legend Returns

New Photography Exhibition Opens at the Cattle Raisers Museum

The Cattle Raisers Museum in Fort Worth is proud to present XIT Ranch: A Texas Legend Returns, a compelling photography exhibition celebrating the legacy and enduring influence of the historic XIT Ranch. The multi-gallery exhibition opens on March 27 and will remain on display through February 2027.

Established in 1885, the XIT Ranch was born from one of the most remarkable land agreements in American history. Financiers John V. Farwell and Charles B. Farwell provided funding for the construction of the Texas State Capitol in exchange for more than three million acres of land in the Texas Panhandle. At its height, the ranch stretched across ten counties and became the world's largest fenced ranch, running as many as 150,000 head of cattle across its vast grasslands.

By the early 20th century, the XIT Ranch had declined. The last cattle bearing the XIT brand were shipped in 1912, and by 1963, the final acre of its vast holdings had passed into new hands. Yet the XIT never truly vanished. Its legacy lived on across the Texas Panhandle in local memory, in rodeo arenas, in businesses, and in the traditions of the communities it helped shape. It was a legend waiting to be revived.

That revival began in 2022, when descendants of John V. Farwell, Drew Knowles and his wife, Abby, purchased the ranch's historic Rita Blanca Division. Moving their family from Colorado, they returned to the land with a deep respect for its history and a forward-looking vision. Today, they steward the ranch with a focus on heritage, thoughtful land management, and progressive ranching practices, bridging the legacy of the past with the promise of the future.

The exhibition brings this history to life through photography that spans more than a century. Visitors will encounter historic XIT images, including one captured by legendary Western photographer Erwin E. Smith, whose photographs from the late 1800s and early 1900s helped define the visual record of ranching and cowboy culture in Texas. They will also step further back in time through an archival gallery wall, which features a historic image of the Texas State Capitol upon its completion in 1887.

Complementing Smith's historic work are contemporary interpretations from a group of respected modern photographers who document ranching culture today. Featured artists include Nicholas Dupuy, a Florida-based photographer and filmmaker known for chronicling modern Western culture; Crystal Wise of 360 West Magazine, who photographed the ranch while producing a feature story highlighting its landscape, people, and revival; and Peter Robbins, a Texas-based photographer and cowboy artist celebrated for documenting working ranches and the lives of cowboys throughout the American West.

Also included is the work of Belton Kleberg McMurrey, a sixth-generation member of the King Ranch family and curator of the exhibition. McMurrey's photography continues a family tradition of documenting ranching life. His images of the King Ranch were previously featured at the museum in 2025.

The exhibition further highlights the work of internationally recognized Western photographer Anouk Krantz, whose bold and cinematic photography offers a powerful interpretation of the modern American West. Her striking imagery bridges tradition and contemporary culture, introducing new audiences to the enduring relevance of ranching life. The XIT Ranch itself appears on the cover of one of Krantz's acclaimed books, *Frontier*, underscoring the ranch's lasting cultural significance.

XIT Ranch: A Texas Legend Returns marks the fourth annual ranching photography exhibition at the Cattle Raisers Museum and offers visitors a rare opportunity to explore the legacy of one of the most legendary ranches in Texas history through the lens of both past and present photographers.

The Cattle Raisers Museum is located inside the Fort Worth Museum of Science and History at 1600 Gendy Street in the Cultural District of Fort Worth.

Pasta Salad with Pepperoni

- 1 box bow tie pasta prepared according to package directions - use Skinner or Barrila brands
- 1 cup sour cream
- 1 cup real mayonnaise...not Miracle Whip
- 1 cup package Hidden Valley Ranch Buttermilk Ranch salad dressing (powdered seasoning packet)
- 1 teaspoon garlic salt or Ballerina Farms Wild Garlic and French Salt
- 2 teaspoons Cajun seasoning (Tony Chachere's Creole Seasoning)
- Juice of 1/2 lemon
- Zest of one entire lemon
- 1 cup cherry tomatoes, whole or cut into halves
- 1 pound cubed sharp or mild cheddar cheese, optional
- 1 cup spinach, shredded in large chunks (optional)
- 1 cup onion sweet white or red (purple) onion, cut into bite-sized chunks
- 1 red bell pepper chopped, into bite-sized chunks
- 1 yellow or orange bell pepper, chopped into bite-sized chunks

Instructions

- Prepare pasta according to package directions.
- Drain well in a colander with cold water to cool the pasta down and stop it from cooking.
- Combine the sour cream and mayonnaise together with spices until blended well.
