# Finding Value in HEREFORDS

*Pittman purchased this C Fantastic 216S grandson from Paul Wade of Antlers, Okla., and has been pleased with his calf crop.*

**Commercial cattleman witnesses advantages of converting to Hereford bulls.**

**W**hen Blake Pittman switched from Charolais bulls to Hereford bulls on his Brangus-based cows, he didn't expect the Hereford calves to perform as well but he's seen the difference. He now is a firm believer and buys Hereford bulls exclusively in his southeastern Oklahoma operation.

Pittman didn't grow up in agriculture. He logged for the forestry industry in Valliant, Okla., for 15 years, but he didn't have a retirement plan. His wife, Brenda, grew up with family running "outside" cattle on leased Weyerhaeuser acreage with no fences in the McCurtain County hills.

The couple decided to buy cattle to fund their retirement in 1995 although both still work full time with the local paper mill. He's since changed jobs and has a retirement plan, but hopes the cattle business will allow for earlier retirement.

Pittman said good neighbors and his wife's family helped him learn the cattle business. Trying a straight Brangus operation 16 to 17 years ago, he changed to Charolais bulls because he wanted a heavier calf.

"The Charolais crosses were good calves, but they weren't what people wanted for mama cows," Pittman said.

Brenda had urged him to try Herefords for several years, and he finally bought Hereford bulls from Paul Wade

of Antlers, Okla., and Lee Terrell of Sherman, Texas. "I went with Herefords to get good steer calves, but yet have females with good maternal traits to raise heifers," he said.

"I needed a terminal cross but something that people would want replacement females from, plus the Hereford temperament is good. That's important to me on the bull too."

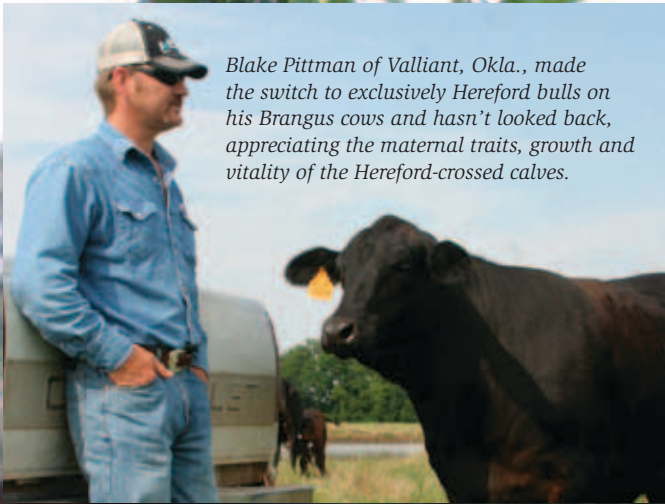
Pittman was so pleased with the results, he switched to exclusively using horned Hereford bulls on his cowherd this year. "People in this area like the black baldy," he said.

He's been surprised with the sound performance of the Hereford-influenced calves in his 120-cow operation. Pittman also noticed another benefit to the Hereford calves. He said they are healthier, and he appreciates the hybrid vigor of the black baldies.

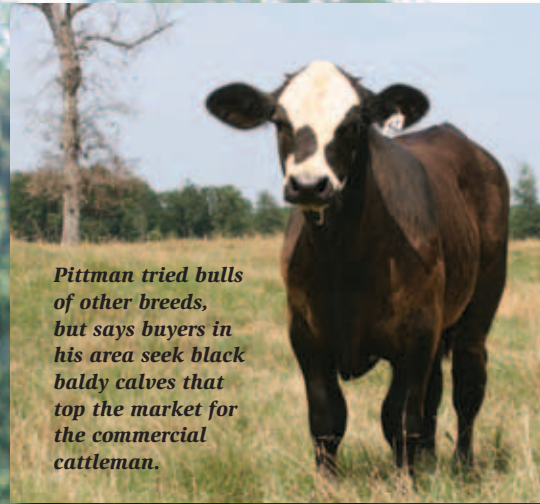
## **Bull Buying Priorities**

When purchasing bulls, Pittman looks for moderate birth weights with even numbers across the board, he said. "I go mostly off EPDs, but I've got to have some visual eye appeal on top of that," he said. The bulls he has bought have had good weaning and yearling weights, and that's important to him.

"Physically, I want one that just looks like a bull," he said. "I like length and easy movement. I want one that is not going to cripple up on you."

When looking at bulls, he values good maternal traits in addition to docile temperament. Cattle in his herd are very gentle due to his culling program and hand feeding of them, he said.

With the exception of one bull bought from the Pirtles of Sunset, Texas, in the All-Breed Bull Sale in Paris, Texas, the last seven bulls purchased have been from Terrell.

Pittman found Terrell through common relationships, asking his tractor dealer where he bought bulls. The man connected him with Dennis Schock, who had dispersed and is now working for the American Hereford Association, but Schock referred Pittman to Terrell. "Schock was busy at a conference when I called, but I appreciated he took the time to give me the numbers."

Pittman finds Terrell to be knowledgeable about bloodlines and prepared when he looks at bulls, having copies of pedigrees available when he is shopping. Terrell takes time to explain cow families and has helped Pittman learn more about Hereford bloodlines.

"He will tell you it's nothing special that he's done," Pittman said. "Lee has just copied the big boys and uses a lot of Holden, Colyer and Cooper genetics. You're not going to drive within two hours and get the same quality of genetics anywhere else," he continued.

Pittman's customers benefit from the same bloodlines serving as cornerstones in many of the nation's top Here-

ford herds. His bull battery consists of an HH Advance 8203 son, plus three 15-month-old sons of CL 1 Domino 863U, a Cooper bull that Terrell bought from Debter Herefords of Alabama. Pittman owns grandsons of HH Advance 5061R, C 212 Domino 4011 and C Fantastic 216S. The 5061R grandson is out of the Holden foundation cow HH Miss Advance 176L who was a donor cow for Dennis Schock of Texas and Jim Coley of Tennessee. Two 176L daughters anchor the donor herd for Colyer Herefords of Idaho.

Pittman values longevity in breeders when buying bulls. "I want someone like Terrell that has been there a while and isn't just fly-by-night. When I called Terrell, instead of saying, 'yeah, I've got a bull you want,' he asked me what my program was. He was interested in what I was trying to do to."

He said Terrell follows up to see how the bulls are performing, and in doing so, they have formed a friendship. "He checks to see if I'm pleased with the calves. If I'm that way, I'll usually swing by and see what he has. Whether he's there or not, I know where they are and go look at the bulls."

### **Pittman's Management Program**

Most of Pittman's cows average 1,300 pounds. "Cows that you really don't notice seem to be your best ones," he said. "They never come up crippled. They never miss a calf."

They are never late. They are good mamas and have a good temperament.”

Pittman uses a controlled 100-day spring calving period, calving 85 percent in the first 60 days. In the fall, he turns in one bull per 25 cows for 42 days. He said it’s cheaper to maintain his cows using this method, although he realizes fall calves weigh and market better. “It’s just easier on my pocketbook.”

Calves are developed on straight grass with a strong preventative vaccination and mineral program. At seven months, most calves average between 550 to 600 pounds. He said switching to Herefords added marketability when sending steer calves north.

Using word of mouth for marketing females, Pittman said every heifer is already spoken for through the next three years by private treaty sales. In late summer, a man from approximately 60 miles away called Pittman. The man had heard about his breeding program and wanted to look at the calves. Pittman said he was impressed at how gentle the calves were and told him on the spot he wanted the entire heifer calf crop for the next three years. Not only did Pittman receive a premium for the Hereford x Brangus crosses, but he has peace of mind and ease of marketing to one person.

Pittman holds his females to high standards. “I’d rather take one to the sale barn than to sell one where someone would be dissatisfied,” he said. “One bad deal can be a lot worse than a million good ones.

“From what I’ve seen, sale barns like the Hereford calves,” he said. “Ever since we’ve been fooling with them, it seems like a baldy will top the sale.”

In addition to the cattle on their 400 acres one mile north of the Red River, the Pittmans also raise Bermuda and Dallas grass hay and pecans as well as one million pounds of poultry annually, growing 125,000 chicks to an end weight of eight pounds. The litter benefits the cattle operation by providing nutrient-rich litter for fertilizer. The litter allows him to easily achieve approximately one cow unit per two acres, running many more cows than he would be able to without the poultry operation.

Raising cattle differs greatly from the contract poultry business, Pittman said. The poultry contract dictates all management and delivery decisions. The cattle business allows him freedom to make his own decisions about breeding, management, health and marketing.

### **Challenges as a Commercial Cattleman**

Pittman views growth as his biggest challenge as a commercial breeder due to high input costs. He said local land used to be reasonable for leasing, but the price has risen so that most of it is being sold instead of leased.

Drought is always a challenge and he has to adapt his feeding program to compensate, but Pittman said we also are challenged as an industry to educate the American public who don’t understand agriculture. “They don’t understand what it takes to get that steak, or how few people actually provide beef, chicken or corn. There’s grown people even in this part of the world who don’t have a clue.

“My son and I were talking the other day about the clean water act. It’s scary what the government is talking about doing with that. We were discussing that we need to get more involved and have a say. That’s one of my goals in addition to producing good quality calves, both steers and females.”

The cattle business has been a labor of love for Blake, Brenda and their three children. “We might not get much sleep, and we take vacations to catch up on the farm,” Pittman said. It’s sometimes crazy, but you have to enjoy it or it wouldn’t be worth it!” ★

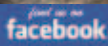

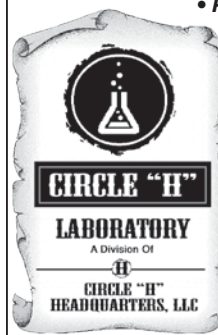
