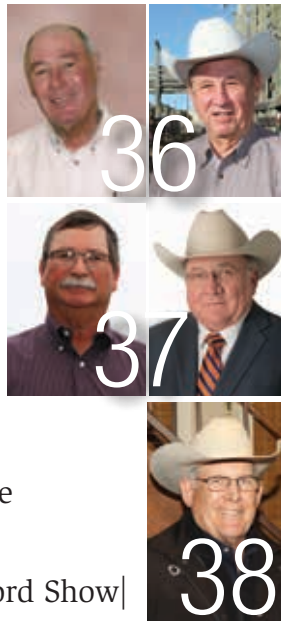

Attention Juniors: \$4,500 for Top Jr. in 2018 Fort Worth National Show

THA Foundation has committed \$4,500 to the exhibitor of the highest placing heifer and \$2,500 to the second highest placing heifer at the 2018 Chris Lacy National Hereford Show in Fort Worth on January 29, 2018. A third and fourth place scholarship of \$1,500 will also be awarded. To be eligible to receive these awards, the exhibitor must be a member of TJHA, be eligible to show in the junior show the previous week (exhibitor does not have to exhibit at the junior show) and be at the halter of his/her heifer. No cow/calf is eligible. The ownership rules for the junior show must be met. See rule 12 on page 191 of the Fort Worth Stock Show premium book.

Friends of THA have sponsored the funds for this award for many years and are committed to making this an annual event and hope to grow the fund to increase the prize as well as create a special belt buckle for the event. Anyone wishing to join this effort should contact Jack Chastain at the THA office. ★

Steve Wayne Coates

Steve Wayne Coates has been a lifelong rancher and third-generation Hereford breeder in Reagan County. He was born May 3, 1947, in San Angelo, Texas, and went to grade school and high school in Big Lake, Texas. After graduating from high school, Steve Wayne attended Texas Tech University, and graduated in 1969 with a degree in Agricultural Economics. Steve Wayne then taught school for a year in Brackettville, Texas, where his older half-brother, P.H. Coates III, was living and ranching. There he met Nan Davis, and they married November 28, 1970. Steve Wayne and Nan moved to Big Lake where he worked at Big Lake State Bank and ranched in partnership with his father, P.H. Coates, Jr. His son Stephen was born in 1971 and his daughter Stephanie was born in 1974. Steve Wayne became president of the First National Bank of Mertzon in 1975, and his family moved to Mertzon in 1976. He became chairman of the board in 1987 and served in this position until his retirement on December 31, 2014.

Coates Ranch was established in 1905 by Steve Wayne's grandfather, P.H. Coates. The registered

cowherd was started in 1927, when P.H. Coates, and his son-in-law, J.A. Queen, purchased 15 heifers and a bull at the Anxiety 4th sale in Snyder, Texas. Every cow on the ranch now traces back to that original purchase. Steve Wayne's father, P.H. Coates, Jr., purchased the herd in 1957, and Steve Wayne formed a partnership with him in 1970 when he moved back to Big Lake. For decades, Hereford cattle, sheep, and goats were the primary source of income for the ranch. Due to market changes and predation, the sheep were all sold in 1998, and the goats in 2004. Steve Wayne was active in the Concho Hereford Association when it was one of the premier sales in the state years ago. He was also active in Texas Sheep and Goat Raisers Association, and remains active in the Reagan County predator control association. Steve Wayne has made it a point to take care of the land, and annually has projects set up for brush control. He has served on the Middle Concho Soil and Water Conservation District board, and recently was recognized for 40 years of service on the board. Steve Wayne helped his kids with their show lambs and show heifers, as well as a few pigs, as they were growing up.

Steve Wayne enjoys ranching and working with the Hereford breed, and now spends his days at the ranch keeping everything in order since he retired from banking. He is very honored and humbled for this Honorary Membership. ★

Loyd bought Rocking Chair Ranch in 1958, and has added ranches in Fort McKavett, Schleicher, and Tom Green County. Today, he has 6 additional ranches where he devotes his time and attention.

A dedicated rancher, stockman, and Hereford Breeder, his enthusiasm for the industry is undeniable. Having Herefords in the family since his Grandfather, Loyd started in the Hereford business in 1963 by purchasing his first groups of heifers from Walter Hill and Sonny Nance. The breeding of these heifers was that of Walter's famed sire, Colorado Domino 161C from the Banning-Lewis Ranches, Colorado Springs, CO. Cattle from other herds were soon added from such noted herds as Hull Dobbs Ranch, Tic Tac Toe Ranch, Albert Mitchell, and Hall-Nance Ranches. The main bloodlines consisted of Battle Intense, Colorado Domino, Husker Mischief, and Mischief.

A believer in continuous breed improvement and development, Loyd believes in the importance of collecting and utilizing performance data and has been doing so from the start. As made available, ultrasound data was later brought in. Present day a solid ET program coupled with a strong cowherd calves twice a year. The dual calving seasons help optimize grazing as well as better serve private treaty customers with cattle year round.

Loyd has remained active in various civic organizations and leadership positions including President of Edward's Burn Association; Director of Hill Country Hereford Association; Director and past President of Concho Hereford Association; 15 years as Director of Texas Hereford Association and past President; Director and

Booster of the Year

E.C. Rosson is a third generation purebred Hereford breeder and current manager of White Rock Hereford Ranch, Inc. owned by E. C. and his four sisters, Lodon, Sherry, Melesa and Teresa. The ranch consists of 2,500 acres running around 275 commercial cows, all Hereford or Hereford influenced, in Hill County near Hillsboro. E.C. says the land is in three Hill County school districts, Itasca, Milford and Hillsboro. E.C. and his sisters were born and raised on the ranch and all were very active in the Texas Junior Hereford Association. They showed only cattle raised by White Rock Hereford Ranch.

E.C. and his sisters all attended school in Itasca. After high school E.C. attended Hill College for 2 years and graduated from Texas A&M University in 1980 with a BS degree in Agriculture Economics. After graduation E.C. worked one year in south Texas as a land man for an oil company based out of San Antonio.

E.C.'s grandfather, Oscar C. Rosson raised purebred Hereford cattle in Scurry and Fischer Counties of Texas. E.C.'s father Eldon C. Rosson and uncles grew up in Snyder, Texas. He is also the chairman of the Fort Worth Livestock Exposition Commercial Female Sale and oversees the group's scholarship program to young people involved in agriculture. He has also received the OSU Animal Science Graduate of Distinction honor in 2016. ★

National Show Honoree

Soft spoken, patient, humble and kind, Chris Lacy is a quintessential great American rancher, meeting disasters such as wildfires, drought, & low cattle prices, along with the daily challenges of ranching with his signature calming smile. Chris is the manager and part owner of the iconic "o6 Ranch" that sits in the majestic high desert of the Davis Mountains between Alpine and Ft. Davis, Texas.

Kokernot Family history intertwines throughout Texas' colorful history. Ancestor David Lee Kokernot served as a Captain in the Texas Navy during the Texas Revolution, fought in the Battle of San Jacinto, and served as a scout for Sam Houston. After the Revolution he and another ship Captain decided to go into ranching in Gonzales. Their brand was registered in 1872 as the "o6" which was the military office designation of Navy Captain. When the partnership dissolved Kokernot kept the brand, later moving the ranching operation by rail to west Texas. In the 1880's they moved to Lubbock and ranched country that is today the home of Texas Tech. In 1912 the Kokernot family moved back to west Texas where they established a successful Hereford operation that continues to present day.

Born a city kid in Waco, TX to Lawrence Lacy, a prominent banker and Mary Ann "Koko" Lacy the daughter of "Mr. Herbert" Kokernot owner of the "o6 Ranch", Chris and his sisters, Elizabeth, Ann, and Golda spent summers and as many holidays as possible on the ranch. Chris fondly remembers his first horseback ride sitting behind the then o6 wagon boss/manager, legendary Ted Gray. In Ted's later years he would state how proud he was of "that city boy and what he made of himself".

Chris was a natural athlete in the saddle or on the field and thought TCU seemed a good fit for his love of football and his preparation for the ranch. He played football for TCU, then took the Ranch Management program. After graduation in 1971 he headed west to stay, becoming manager in 1973.

Under Chris' management the ranch has vastly improved, but is still run the traditional way because the vast, rugged, mountain terrain of West Texas dictates it. The "o6 Ranch" still pulls out the wagon, tepees, a crew of 15-18 cowboys, and runs a savvy remuda of A.Q.H.A. horses. Roundups are 2 weeks of branding in the Spring and 4 weeks of gathering in the Fall.

Herefords are the breed of choice, but other breeds have been tried over the years due to trends and marketing values. "Herefords have proven themselves to us in this region. We have seen Herefords utilize the higher, rougher country during periods of drought and hold their body conditions better."

Some of the improvements under Chris's management are better roads, water systems, hunting and wildlife management programs and an outstanding string of AQHA horses. Prior to Chris' management, wild horses were bought by the truckload and things got pretty western. Chris started registering colts with the A.Q.H.A. in 1979 and today the "o6" horses are known for being big-boned athletic horses, with a big work ethic, good minds and easy on the eye.

Along with the endless tasks needed to be done to keep the o6 running, Chris makes time to give back to the community and state of Texas. He currently serves as the Pres. of the hospital board in Alpine, a board member of TX. Livestock Marketing, the National Finance Credit Assoc., the Davis Mountain Trans Pecos Heritage Assoc., the Alpine Cowboy baseball team, and the Paisano Baptist Encampment. He is now a T.S.C.R.A. Honorary director, a past director of The Texas Hereford Assoc., a past Pres. for the Highland Hereford Assoc., a past Pres. of the Rio Grande Electric Coop. In 2013 Chris was honored to be a recipient of the "Foy Proctor Cowman Award". He and wife Dawn attend Big Bend Cowboy Church in Alpine.

Chris and Dawn share a blended family of Kristin and her husband Buddy Cavness, Lance Lacy and wife Brandee, Matt Roelli and wife Eryn, and grandchildren Madison, Mason, Christian, Katherine, Olivia, Judah and Sadie. All enjoy being on the ranch as much as possible.

With no signs of retiring, many visions of improvements, and a strong sense of stewardship, the Kokernot o6 ranch is in good hands. ★

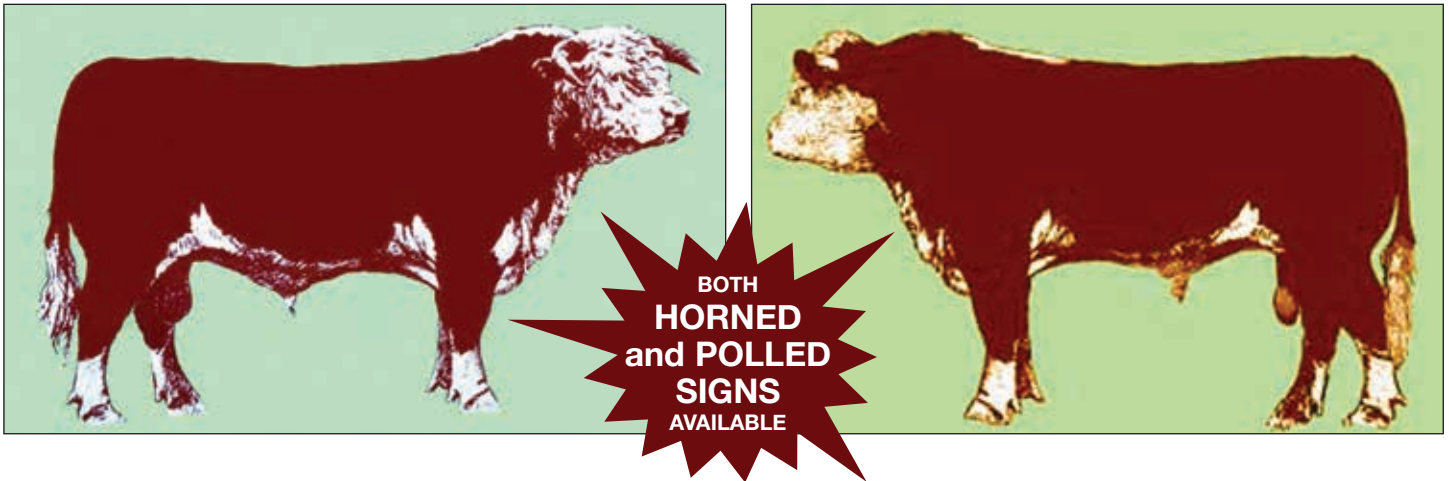

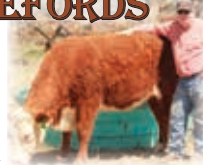
