Replacement Female Sale – Cowtown Invitational Entries

Now is the time to make your selections for both the 50th Annual Whiteface Replacement Female Sale and Cowtown Invitational Sale. Special events are being planned to celebrate the 50th anniversary of the Whiteface Replacement Female sale.

For the first time, Red Angus x Hereford cross-bred heifers will be allowed to show and sell in the Whiteface Replacement Sale. This first year, the Red and Black cross bred will show together.

Entries for the Whiteface Replacement sale are due to the THA office

by November 1, 2018. Consignments to the Cowtown Invitational Sale are due to THA office by September 15, 2018 and cattle must be entered in the Fort Worth Stock Show by November 15, 2018.

Although entries are not due until fall, bred heifers need to be put with bulls at this time. Invitational sale consignments should be identified and nominated early, as only a limited number of cattle will be accepted. Note that the sale dates are Sunday, February 3, 2019. ★

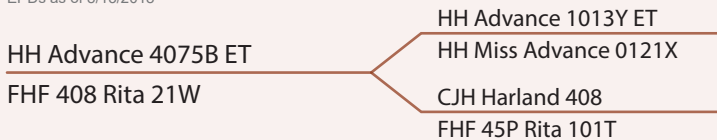

When Matt and Morgan Brewer's newborn daughter, Kaci, received the diagnoses of Spina Bifida, hydrocephalus, and a Chiari II Malformation, they worried about the struggles their tiny girl would face. The family, however, turned to their faith in God and the fantastic clinicians at the West Texas Rehabilitation Center (WTRC) and Kaci is doing things they never believed were possible.

Kaci has been receiving care at WTRC since she was five months old when she started in physical, occupational, and speech therapies. Because of her Chiari II Malformation, a condition in which the brain tissue extends into the spinal canal, Kaci had to endure brain surgery to lift her brain stem from her spinal cord. The procedure affected her ability to eat and swallow foods. As a result, Kaci receives feeding therapy where the speech therapist introduces new foods weekly to teach her to explore a variety of textures and eat safely.

Though there is still work ahead, Kaci has come so far in her development and has improved with her mobility where she is now able to walk independently of a walker with the assistance of braces. She even uses a bike that she controls with her legs and arms.

Kaci and her older sister Karley, who, according to mom is the best big sister in the world, love playing with dolls and being girly, but the two girls also love being outdoors, especially if they can go fishing.

Matt and Morgan are very thankful for the clinical staff at WTRC as they treat not only Kaci but all of the Brewers as if they are family. Morgan is grateful for WTRC and the fact that kids like Kaci have a place to go to for the care and the tools they need to thrive and progress.

How Innovative Technology

Can Keep Traditions Alive for Generations to Come

The Butler's have accomplished a lot over the past 34 years. They have raised a daughter, taught her the ins and outs of the cattle industry, helped provide her with the proper education to begin her career of choice, seen her married, and now enjoy a grandson and granddaughter who will begin their own show career in just a few years. They also have built a successful cow calf operation.

While their daughter was growing up, it was their dream to build a herd of registered Hereford cattle from a champion bloodline that started from a 1974 National Champion Polled Hereford named Miss America. Through years of selective breeding, keep/cull decisions, and countless prayers, they developed a family tree with many branches of show heifers for their daughter.

She showed them. She cared for them. She learned from them. She loved them. Then, her time in the show ring ended.

Consequentially, the old show heifers, one by one, began to retire from reproductivity and ultimately pass away. As the last decade passed, the Butler's found themselves with a successful commercial business, but left with only one purebred show heifer from the bloodline they toiled so much over to build.

They were faced with a decision: let the bloodline and 30 years of hard work die, or do something about it. There was just one problem. The only show heifer left was nearing the end of her reproductive life. If she was able to breed again, this single animal would never be able to bring the bloodline back to where it was before. Cue science and technology.

There is an old saying that God gave us two hands: one to help others, and one to help ourselves. We have been given a mind, intelligence, and a drive for creativity. When it would have been easier to let it all fade away, I am proud that my parents made the decision to invest in flushing.

Flushing and recip cows are not a new thing. Even though the technology was first used in rabbits way back in the 1890s this is still a technically advanced procedure. The first calf born from embryo transfer wasn't born until 1981. It provides an amazing opportunity for ranchers of cattle, sheep, goats, horses, and all livestock to continue producing champions, not only in the ring, but also in the pasture.

In a world where so many things are unpredictable and out of our control, it is comforting to know that we have been blessed enough to live in a free country, capable of researching and implementing these procedures so that hard working American ranchers, like my parents, can continue raising something they fought so hard to create. James and Emilia will be so very grateful to be able to show animals two and three generations out from the animals that I showed.

Let us not forget the importance of tradition, the thrill of curiosity, the drive to learn, and the blessing of our creativity from the ultimate Creator. Embracing all of these just might mean being able to watch your grandchildren show a heifer from the bloodline that has been in the works for over 4 decades. ★

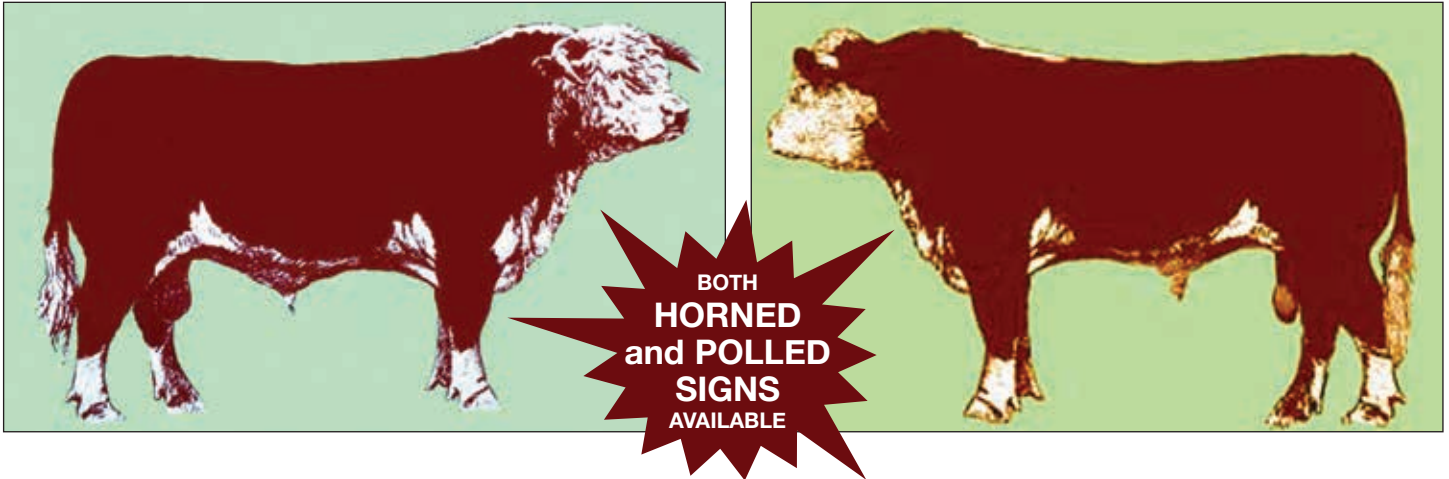
